A 9ct gold, mother-of-pearl and red enamelled dress set, comprising a pair of cufflinks, diameter of each front 1.4cm, four buttons and two studs, Birmingham 1961-1963, total weight 17.8g (one stud lacking), with a Harrods fitted case.

Condition Report

One cufflink front has a noticeable scratch across its diameter, marking both the enamel and mother-of-pearl, the other front of this cufflink also has a small scratch to the enamel. The other cufflink appears to be in good condition.

One dress button has a small chip to the mother-of-pearl.

One stud is lacking.

Otherwise the other pieces are in fairly good condition. Some typical scratching to the gold backs.

The case has some slight staining to the interior silk, otherwise in generally good condition.
