A platinum and diamond ring, claw set with the principal circular cut diamond between diamond five stone shoulders, mark rubbed, weight 3.2g, principal diamond weight approx 1.65ct, ring size approx T1/2.

Condition Report

Minimal wear to the sides of the setting.

The shank is generally fairly thin. The marks to the interior of the shank are rubbed. Possible remains of a number - '3612?', plus some pawnbrokers marks.

Side diamonds possibly 0.005ct each - generally well matched, all single cut stones.

Principal diamond carat weight approx 1.65ct.

Diamond grading (estimations and limited by the setting): Colour G/H, Clarity VS

No chips to the diamonds.
