## LOT 598

A Stuart gold and faceted rock crystal drop shaped pendant, late 17th century, designed as three ladies seated at a table with a young blackamoor in the foreground, unmarked, weight 3.5g, length 2.7cm.

Estimate: £700 - £900

## Condition Report

Some general abrasion to the table facet edge of the rock crystal. Some light scratching to the table, largely noticeable when viewed under a 10x loupe.

The odd small dent to the back of the piece. Some general light scratching overall to the metal.

The protruding point at the base of the piece is the remains of a support, possibly which held a drop which is now lacking.

Some general expected deterioration to the interior scene, largely seen as flaking of colours, to the clothing and faces, as well as to the foil backing.
