A Victorian gold, diamond and carbuncle garnet oval pendant locket, the front with a diamond set six pointed star motif on a carbuncle garnet ground, with a carbuncle garnet set suspension loop, the back glazed with an oval woven hair locket compartment, unmarked, weight 13.5g, length 4.1cm.

Estimate: £500 - £700

Condition Report

The main garnet has a small internal fracture which is just about surface reaching, on the right side. There are some scratches and nicks to the surface of this garnet.

Some evidence of moisture within the locket compartment. Small scratch to the glazing.

Diamonds appear secure, if a little dirty.

Minor losses to the gold setting surrounding the garnet surmount, but the stone is still secure.

Some typical light scratching and one or two small dents to the metal overall.

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
