A late 19th century Scottish plated and ram's horn table snuff mull of oval form, the hinged lid with foliate finial above floral and foliate scroll decoration, flanked by two plate tipped ram's horns, on three paw feet, height 21.5cm, length 44cm.

Condition Report

345 - Generally good condition. The plated mounts have surface wear to the plate. Typical surface scratches. Some minor blistering to plate to interior. Hinge is good. Horns with typical natural shrinkage cracks. Otherwise in generally good order with only minor nicks.
