Condition Report

408. Both bases have thin cracks to them and are a bit discoloured, but the coasters do not wobble. They have an engraved stag's head crest to one panel. Both of the silver frames fit a bit loosely to their bases and have overall surface wear and dinks. Both have a break and slight loss to the trellis panels, as well as some surface cracks around edge of base.
