## LOT 360

An early Victorian silver equestrian trophy cup and cover of urn form, the domed cover surmounted by a figure of a horse above chased floral and foliate decoration, framed by a cast foliate scroll rim, the front relief decorated with a jockey on horseback opposing an engraved crest of a horse and tree, flanked by two bellflower and scroll handles, on a reeded knob stem and similarly decorated circular foot, London 1846 by John Samuel Hunt, weight 2699.6g, height 43cm.

## Condition Report

360. The general condition is quite good overall with just some minor wear and a few minor dinks to rim. The main issue is the dents and creases around the reverse panel, where it has probably been tinned slightly from an inscription removal. It is not that thin but there are a number of dents and creases to this area. The horse finial is very slightly leaning to one side.
