A Mappin & Webb part canteen of plated and faux ivory handled Athenian pattern cutlery, comprising five tablespoons, twelve table knives and forks, twelve dessert forks and spoons, eleven dessert knives, twelve soup spoons, soup ladle, two sauce ladles, twelve fish knives and forks, serving fish fork, twelve fruit knives and forks, fourteen teaspoons, pair of sugar tongs, carving knife and steel and tin opener, together with a matched plated serving fish knife, contained within an oak two-drawer canteen table.

The cutlery is in generally good order, however all the ivorex handles have a slight gapping to the metalware, which is much worse on the fish set where there is quite a big gap.
