A sapphire and diamond brooch, 1920s, in a circular openwork design with a tied bow motif, mounted with rose cut diamonds and calibre cut sapphires, unmarked, weight 5.5g, diameter 3.2cm, with an associated case.

Condition Report

A couple of the sapphires have chips. Four or five diamonds are chipped, one badly on one side.

Clasp in good order, fastening tightly.

Typical light scratching to the metal. Possible slight solder repair to the hinge of the clasp.
