A diamond ring, claw set with the two principal cushion cut diamonds in a crossover design between diamond three stone shoulders, unmarked, weight 4.1g, total diamond weight approx 1.10ct-1.20ct, ring size approx O, with a case.

### Condition Report

Principal diamonds - one has a chip to the girdle. One has a fracture running beneath a claw to the table. Clarity I, the other is SI approximately.

Diamonds generally well matched for colour - approx I/J on average.

Some wear to the sides of the setting, typical light scratching to the shank overall.

Suggested age - might be mid-20th century.
