A pair of Worcester pierced cress dishes, circa 1780, printed in underglaze blue with the Pine Cone Group, hatched crescent marks in underglaze blue to bases, diameter 19cm, together with a Worcester tureen, cover and stand, printed in underglaze blue with the Pine Cone Group and its reverse print the Ripe Pomegranate, its branch handles with relief foliate terminals, hatched and open crescent marks to bases, length of stand including handles 30cm (chips and losses to handle terminals).

### Condition Report

1668. One cress dish with a couple of nibbles to the footrim, otherwise both dishes in generally good condition. Some chipping and losses to the applied floral handles of the tureen, cover and stand. Some scratching to the interior of the tureen. Small hairline crack to the stand, with a small chip to the underside of the rim and a few scratches.
