A threaded glass 'Peacock Eye' finger bowl, Stevens & Williams or Stuart & Son, produced for Liberty, circa 1900, the clear body with yellow and blue eye detail, diameter 13.7cm, together with a similar cranberry example with trailed green decoration, diameter 13cm.

Condition Report

1898. Cranberry example - small crack to the colourless collar of the body.

Peacock Eye - slight scuff to the yellow detailing of one peacock eye, a small manufacturing flaw to the ribbed detailing of the main body, but this is us being picky! In fairly good condition.
