A set of eight Jodhpur range harlequin hock wine glasses, decorated by Heckert, early 20th century, each rounded bowl enamelled and gilt with an Islamic style cut and engraved foliate style design, raised on cut tapered stems and similarly decorated feet, height 20.5cm, together with five cranberry flashed and cut wines, height 11.5cm.

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

1841. Cranberry glasses - one with possible repaired stem, others with the odd nick to bowl in particular. Jodhpur - one with scratch on stem directly below bowl, two with noticeable small areas of loss to the bowl's decoration. Overall very minor losses to gilt rims.
