LOT 1866

A double series opaque twist stem wine glass, circa 1770, the ogee bowl on a plain stem with a pair of five-ply spiral threads outside a multi-ply corkscrew, on a conical foot, height 16cm, a similar smaller glass, height 11.3cm, three engraved glasses with folded feet, an engraved ale glass, a Continental rectangular decanter and a group of mixed mostly 19th century glasses.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1866. Small handled glass - crack to handle where joins body.

Faceted ale glass - scratches to base of bowl

Engraved conical bowl - fault on bowl, possibly happened during production

Small engraved glass - nibbled rim

Double series glass - small nibble to footrim

Squat form engraved glass - distinctly lop sided, some manufacturing faults to the bowl, uneven foot

Decanter - water stain to interior

All other in fairly good condition, though many have trapped bubbles, unevenness of form due to being hand blown.
