A pair of olive green tinted crackle glass vases, probably Moser, early 20th century, of bottle form with urn shaped necks, enamelled with aquatic weed, height 19.5cm, together with a similar larger two-handled example, height 23cm. Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Condition Report

1874. Crackle vases - some minor nibbling to the neck and body. One with a couple of small nicks to the enamel decoration.

Larger vase - some very minor rubbing to enamel in places, otherwise in fairly good condition.
