A Pablo Picasso white earthenware Bull and Picador pitcher, circa 1956, the oxidized paraffin decoration depicting a picador on horseback flanked by trees and a bull beyond, indistinct impressed marks to base and inscribed 'EDITION PICASSO', height 13cm. Note: a similar example is illustrated by Alain Ramie in 'Picasso - Catalogue of the edited ceramic works 1947-1971', p.189, pl.369. Here it notes 500 copies of this design were produced. Provenance: property of a Sussex private collector.

Condition Report

1497. Generally good condition, all-over light crazing, no significant damage, restoration or repairs. Small unglazed area to inside of spout ($2 \text{cm} \times 0.7 \text{cm}$), small flake of glaze loss to tip of spout ($2 \text{cm} \times 0.5 \text{cm}$). Some typical minor pitting to glaze, typical minor surface scratches and wear.
