A rare Hans Coper studio pottery 'Treacle Pot', 1950s, of simple footed beaker form, decorated with vertical lines covered in a rich treacle glaze above the unglazed foot, impressed seal mark, height 13cm (minor flat chip to foot). Provenance: property of a Sussex private collector.

## Condition Report

1499. The pot is in generally good condition. Small flat chip to foot which is illustrated in image 8 on our website. Typical light crazing to glaze of exterior and interior (see images 1-4 and 6). No cracks or restoration. Typical light surface scratches and wear. Good clear impressed mark to base. Minor discolouration/staining to an area of crazing near rim, can be seen in image 4 online.
