A Lucie Rie studio pottery stoneware bottle vase with volcanic glaze, the baluster body with flared undulating rim, the erupted glaze with copper red details against a blue/grey ground, impressed seal marks to base, height 26cm (minor restoration to rim). Provenance: property of a Sussex private collector.

Estimate: £3,000 - £5,000

Condition Report

1500. There is a section of rim (approx 12.5cm in length) which has been broken out in 3 pieces and restored with some overpainting. There is then a small hairline which runs down vertically from this area of repair. There is then a small V-shaped area of the rim which has been broken out and similarly restored (approx 5.5cm x 2cm). Otherwise the rest of the neck and body appear to be in good order. Vibrant glaze. Good clear impressed mark to base.
