### Condition Report

1411. Vase decorated with a lily - hairline crack to rim  
Oval clover dishes - some minor rubbing to rims  
Circular basketweave bowl - chip to rim  
Pink rimmed cup and saucer - both with some wear to the gilt rim  
Jug with branch handle - badly cracked  
Globular closer jug - tiniest of nicks to rim  
Shell jug - nibble to rim, crossed out mark to base so second quality  
Larger globular clover jug - rubbing to the handle

All other pieces in generally good condition.
