A Zurich porcelain teacup and saucer, late 18th century, painted in puce, the saucer with wildfowl, the cup with a village landscape, underglaze marks to bases, diameter of saucer 13.8cm, together with a Doccia Tulip pattern coffee cup and saucer, late 18th century, diameter of saucer 13.8cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

1428. Zurich saucer - 2 or 3 small chips to the rim and to the footrim. Some slight scratching to the centre, particularly evident on the bird's necks.

Zurich cup - small manufacturing flaw, largely hidden amongst the print, otherwise ok.

Doccia saucer - 3-4 small chips to rim, some scratching to the centre, with some more noticeable losses to the floral decoration, some rubbing to the gilt.

Doccia cup - tiny nibble to the footrim, very small losses to the floral decoration and rubbing to gilt.
