A pair of cut and engraved club shaped decanters and stoppers, Continental, 19th century, each engraved with a ribbon tied foliate garland above slant-cut detail and stylized fleurs-de-lys, the necks and stoppers faceted, height 28cm, together with a group of mostly engraved decanters, carafes and jugs, including a large footed jug, engraved with passion flowers, height 30cm, and a faceted jug, etched with birds amidst foliage, height 22.3cm (minor faults). Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Condition Report

1844. Ovoid jug - very small crack to body just below the lower handle joint.

Star etched ewer with twist handle - cloudy, otherwise good.

Star etched ewer with loop handle - a little cloudy and matched stopper, otherwise good.

All other pieces in good clean condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear.

Please note, 3 decanters are missing their stoppers as can be seen in the images online.
