### LOT 1857

A large mixed group of uranium and uranium decorated or detailed glassware, British and Continental, early 20th century, including a Bagley Art Deco Marine bowl, diameter 23cm, an Art Deco bowl with bird handles, length 34cm, an assortment of ice glass jugs, vases and glasses, and a set of five plates, diameter 19cm. Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

### Condition Report

1857. Moulded oval bowl with bird handles - small chip to rim.

Crackled vase with green applied flower - minor chips to feet but nothing significant.

Clear crackled jug with spiral reeded body - crack across top of handle.

Two crackled tapered beakers - both with minor rim chips.

Frill rim bowl - small chip to rim.

All other pieces in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear. Five plates with slightly more pronounced surface scratches.
