A Jaeger-LeCoultre Automatic stainless steel circular cased gentleman's wristwatch with signed and jewelled 2883 caliber movement, the signed silvered dial with baton hour markers and date aperture, the case back numbered '993456', case diameter 3.1cm, on a leather strap, together with a Longines Conquest Automatic steel gentleman's wristwatch, the signed silvered dial with baton hour markers and date aperture, case diameter 3.4cm.

Condition Report

1208. Jaeger-LeCoultre watch - the movement winds and adjust smoothly, date rolls over as it should, and is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

The dial has some discolouration around the edge particularly at 1 o'clock. Minor pitting and marks visible in the online images on our website.

Case with typical surface scratches and wear, also a little dirty so would benefit from a clean. Glass/crystal is scratched.

Leather strap is worn.

Longines watch - the movement winds and adjusts smoothly, date rolls over as it should, and it is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

The dial is generally good with some faint pitting and marks.

Typical surface scratches and wear to case and glass.

Enamel loss to emblem on back of case, a little dirty and would benefit from a clean.

Mesh strap with wear.
