A First World War period Rolex silver circular hunting cased gentleman's trench wristwatch with signed and jewelled movement, the black gloss dial with luminous Arabic hour numerals and subsidiary seconds and detailed 'Asprey', the signed W & D case back and hinged front numbered '654532' and '654533', import mark London 1915, case diameter 3.5cm.

### Condition Report

1138. The movement winds and adjusts smoothly and is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

Dial is a little worn, some small chips to edges of luminous hour markers. Minor scratches and a little dirty. Silver case with typical light surface scratches and wear. Small dent to centre of front. Front hinge a little loose. Back screws down tightly.

Lugs slightly misshapen. Good clear hallmarks.

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
