A Seiko World Time Diashock Automatic steel cased gentleman's wristwatch with signed and jewelled movement, the signed silvered dial with baton hour markers, outer 24-hour dial and surrounding named cities of the world, with date aperture, the case back numbered '7901743', case diameter 3.7cm, on a leather strap, together with a Seiko 5 Automatic steel cased gentleman's wristwatch, the signed black dial with baton hour markers and day and date aperture, the case back numbered '341665', case diameter 3.6cm, on a leather strap.

Movement winds and adjusts smoothly and is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Date rolls over as it should and inner bezel is rotating via the winding button/crown. Later leather bracelet.

Seiko 5 - generally good condition with some surface scratches and wear to case and glass. Dial looks ok. The movement winds and adjusts smoothly, day and date roll over as they should and the watch is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Leather strap is worn.
