An 18ct gold cased keywind open-faced pocket watch, the gilt fusee movement detailed 'Jas Johnson, London', 18ct gold inner case, the engine turned gilt dial with gilt Roman numerals, London 1823, weight 85.4g, case diameter 4.5cm, with replacement metal bow and two keys.

Condition Report

1062. Case with typical wear and surface scratches, more pronounced wear to engine turning to case back and a number of small dents to case back. Cast borders and sides in generally good order with no significant damage. Dial is nice and clean. Replacement bow. Both hinges are good. Hallmarks a little worn but readable. The movement winds but is not currently running.

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
