A late 19th/early 20th century lacquered brass carriage timepiece with eight day movement, the cream chapter ring with black Arabic hour numerals, within a pierced gilt floral and scroll surround, the case with fluted swing handle and corner columns, on turned feet, height 15.4cm, together with an early 20th century chinoiserie cased mantel timepiece, height 23.3cm (one foot chipped).

Condition Report

1261. Carriage timepiece in generally not particularly good order. It does not wind or run. Both glass side panels with damaged corners. Case with typical wear. Dial is good.

Chinoiserie timepiece has worn case, chip to corner of front foot and dirty dial. The movement does not wind or run.

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
