A late 19th century French lacquered brass cased carriage clock with eight day movement striking on a gong, the cream circular dial with black Arabic hour numerals, within a finely pierced and engraved gilt surround of foliate scrolls, the glazed case with swing handle above fluted and tulip cusp corner columns, on bracket feet, height 14.3cm.

Condition Report

1239. Case with typical wear to lacquering, top of case a little dirty, but otherwise ok. Chip to bottom right corner of front glass panel, other glass panels in good condition. Dial in good order. The clock does not run or strike.

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
