A late 19th century French Paris porcelain cased clock and stand, the clock with eight day movement striking on a bell via an outside countwheel, the circular enameled dial with black Roman hour numerals and signed 'Raingo a Paris', the rococo scroll moulded balloon shaped case painted with a scene of a pheasant and flowers, reserved against a gilt overlaid green ground, the stand similarly decorated, total height 33.2cm, with pendulum (minor faults).

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

1272. The porcelain case and stand in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical rubbing and wear to gilt and paintwork. Stand with more pronounced wear from the clock case feet rubbing against it.

The movement winds smoothly and runs, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

The dial is cracked.

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
