LOT 1288

An early 19th century mahogany longcase clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the 12-inch painted breakarch dial with rolling moon to arch, Arabic hour numerals, subsidiary seconds and date aperture, the hood with moulded arch pediment and glazed door, the trunk with arched door, on a plain base and plinth, height 201cm, with pendulum and two weights.

Estimate: £50 - £100

Condition Report

1288. Generally fair condition commensurate with age. Some visible woodworm to sides of hood. Typical scuffs and wear to case. Missing finials. Glass side panel of hood cracked. Some wear and misshaping to capitals on hood columns. Hood escutcheon damaged. Hinges are good to hood door and trunk door. Trunk door with chips to edges. Dial a little dirty and worn with craquelure. Minor chips to edges. Movement winds smoothly but is a little dirty so would benefit from a clean/service which should bring it back to working order.

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
