1251. Typical surface scratches and wear to lacquered brass case. Minor chip to bottom left corner of glass front panel and chips to corners of glass back door panel. Back door with replacement knob/handle. Dial with crack to top right corner. Movement winds smoothly and is currently running, strike and repeat mechanism also in good working order, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.
