### LOT 1292

A 19th century mahogany longcase clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the 13-inch painted breakarch dial with Roman hour numerals, subsidiary seconds and date dials, and indistinctly signed, the arch painted with animals and birds in a woodland, the hood with swan neck pediment and inlaid columns, the bowfront trunk with arched door and spiral reeded corner columns, on a crossbanded bowfront base and bracket feet, height 214cm, with pendulum and two weights.

Estimate: £100 - £200

### Condition Report

1292. Generally good condition commensurate with age. Missing finials to hood and missing ends of bracket feet to base (cut down). Otherwise hood and case in generally good condition with no significant damage. Dial with typical wear and craquelure. Four holes to arch where automaton may have one been fitted. Will require clean/service to return to working order.

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
