An early 19th century French brass rectangular cased carriage alarm clock, the pocket watch movement with verge escapement and pierced and engraved balance cock, the silvered dial with black Roman hour numerals, the case with folding handle and engraved decoration, the sliding case back numbered '259' and '249', height 9.1cm (some faults).

Condition Report

1240. Case with wear. Glass front chipped to edges. Loose fastenings and some missing. Silvered dial with typical light wear and scratches, otherwise ok. The movement is not running.

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
