A 19th century scrimshaw whalebone walking cane with spiral reeded, ring turned and reeded tapering shaft, the cube and octagonal upper section with baleen inlaid decoration, beneath a marine ivory octagonal pommel, length approx 86.5cm.

2543. The central ribbed section of the shaft halfway down has a filled area of resin repair and a small filled hole which is probably covering a pin. The tip has a crack to the ferule, but otherwise in good condition.
