## LOT 550

A silver, moonstone, blister pearl, Swiss lapis and chalcedony pendant necklace, possibly by Amy Sandheim, first half of the 20th century, the front in a pierced scrolling foliate design, mounted with a large oval cabochon Swiss lapis to the centre, on a T-bar clasp, unmarked, weight 62.2g, length 78cm.

Estimate: £300 - £500

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## Condition Report

At the back of the largest pendant section there is a split to one hollow bead, but this is largely insignificant.

The smaller pendant section has had a brooch fitting added to the back.

The silver backing to the one of the abalone shells on the neckchain is slightly dented.

Otherwise the piece is in generally good condition, with minimal rubbing or scratching to the gemstones. The piece would benefit from a clean.

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
