A gold and bloodstone oval signet ring, engraved with an arm holding a sword between motto 'Conjuncta virtuti fortuna', unmarked, weight 6.2g, ring size approx M1/2, and a gold signet ring, initial engraved, detailed '18', weight 6.1g, ring size approx H1/2.

Condition Report

Bloodstone signet ring - light scratching to the bloodstone, the interior of the shank has an addition, later added, panel of metal which is perhaps gold, but unmarked. Any hallmarks to indicate the carat of gold of the main shank are subsequently lost under this panel.

The ring has not been tested.

Signet ring - it is detailed '18', which would indicate 18ct gold, but we have not tested to confirm this. Some rubbing to the initials. There is an inscription to the back of the head of the ring '6th Nov 1914'.

Both rings have typical scratching/rubbing to the shanks/settings.
