A Victorian coromandel cased travelling vanity box, the compartmentalized interior fitted with eleven silver gilt topped glass bottles and jars, each monogram engraved within strapwork and scroll decoration, London 1878 by Thomas Whitehouse, together with three matched silver gilt handled manicure implements, weight of eight covers 440.2g, the brass bound case fitted with a drawer, height 21.5cm, length 33.5cm (some glass damaged).

Condition Report

320. Generally ok, but a bit tired, dirty and worn. The coromandel has a horizontal split to the back panel. Few veneer splits to edges of the cover and typical surface scratches and wear. Interior mirror is a little precarious with splits to leather surround, so loose in its frame. All silver gilt is worn, various chips to glass and one rectangular box smashed.
