1009. Generally good condition, no significant damage or repairs.

Typical light crazing to glaze, but no chips, cracks or restoration.

Some rubbing/wear to enamels and gilt.

Some losses to the black enamelling to the keyfret border around the foot.

Nicely painted mark to base.
