Condition Report

1080. Generally good condition. Small drilled hole to just above the gilt foot on the body, where it was once used as a table lamp.

Otherwise typical light surface scratches and wear.

Small dent to one side of body, but no significant damage or repairs.

Typical scratches and wear to gilt rim and foot.
