A pair of Chinese famille rose export porcelain octagonal plates, Yongzheng period, each painted and gilt with a goose amidst peony within a pomegranate panel and trellis border, width 21.8cm (one cracked, the other repaired), together with a pair of Chinese famille rose export porcelain circular plates, Qianlong period, each with scattered flowers, diameter 23.3cm (one with hairline to rim).

Estimate: £150 - £200

Condition Report

1103. Octagonal plate 1 - broken in half and rivet repaired. Typical minor nicks/chips to rim. Typical surface scratches and wear to glaze and enamels. Minor loss to pink flower glaze.

Octagonal plate 2 - star crack to centre and typical surface scratches and wear to glaze and enamels. Minor rim chips.

Circular plate 1 - generally good condition, minor chip to rim, otherwise no cracks or repairs. Typical surface scratches and wear.

Circular plate 2 - 5.5cm hairline and small chips to rim. Typical surface scratches and wear to enamels and glaze.
