A Japanese brown patinated bronze and mixed metal decorated vase by Asada, Meiji period, of squat globular form, worked in relief with iris flowers and leaves, stamped maker's seal mark to base, height 6.3cm, together with a Japanese cloisonné vase, Meiji period, of tapering form, decorated with blossoming tree on a black ground, height 9cm.

Condition Report

1016. Bronze vase - three small dent to body (one just to left of ins, other two beside each other on reverse of body). Wear to patina around dents and typical surface scratches and wear, otherwise ok.

Cloisonne vase - generally good condition, some minor stress hairlines visible under magnification. Typical light surface scratches and wear. No significant damage or repairs.
