Condition Report

1036. Kutani vase - good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light crazing and minor wear to gilt.

Satsuma vase - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light crazing.

Small Satsuma bowl - faint hairline to rim, crazed, and wear to gilt.

Both Satsuma dishes in good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs. Light crazing and only minor wear to gilt.
