A pair of Chinese cloisonné jars and covers, 20th century, each of stout ovoid form with Buddhistic lion finial, decorated with polychrome flowering stems and scrolling foliage on a whorl-filled blue ground, height 15.5cm (one base panel missing), with carved wood stands, together with a Chinese cloisonné circular bowl, decorated with polychrome flowers and scrolling leafy tendrils on a blue ground, four-character mark to base, diameter 30cm.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

1089. Cloisonne bowl - good condition, no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear. Rim a little dirty, minor misshaping to footrim.

Jar 1 - good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Cover in good order with only minor enamel loss to interior beneath finial.

Jar 2 - missing base panel. Very minor enamel loss to the centre of a couple of whorls, but fairly insignificant. Cover ok, but minor misshaping to inner rim and minor enamel loss to interior.
