LOT 558

A cabochon sapphire and diamond ring, mounted with the oval cabochon sapphire within an openwork surround set with cushion cut diamonds, indistinct mark, weight 4.4g, ring size approx K1/2.

Estimate: £180 - £220

Condition Report

Cabochon sapphire has a few surface scratches, and one or two surface reaching inclusions to the sides. It is a heavily included stone. Approx. size: 6.2mm x 5.5mm x 4.15mm.

In general the diamonds are old cut stones with some variation of shape. On average charity SI, colour K/L. The larger diamonds perhaps 0.05ct each, the other stones too small to measure in the setting.

There appear to be one or two repairs to the collet settings.

The mark to the shank is heavily rubbed, only a 'T' remains. Some areas of the metal appear to be wearing down to a yellow colour, which may suggest the ring is white gold, but this is only an opinion and has not been confirmed by test. The wear to the piece may suggest rhodium plating but again this is only an opinion.

The ring has been resized in the past.

Some thinning to the back of the shank, typical light scratching/scuffing to the shank/setting overall.

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
