A late Victorian 15ct gold, diamond and varicoloured agate mourning ring, the shank exterior mounted with a row of five varicoloured marquise shaped agates, otherwise mounted with an old cut diamond on a square ground, engraved within the shank 'In Loving Memory of My Mother April 29th 1895', Chester 1895, weight 2.3g, ring size approx N.

Estimate: £200 - £250

Condition Report

General scratching and scuffing to metal, tiny dent to edge of the square front.

A few small nibbles to the edges of the hardstones.

The silvery mark seen in the image is impacted dirt and will remove with a clean.

Some slight losses of definition to the engraved decoration but generally the ring is in good condition for its age.

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
