A 9ct gold Masonic fob with a central crown motif, London 1930, length 2.8cm, a gold Masonic pendant, designed as a square and compasses, detailed '9ct', total weight 7.9g, a gold and mother-of-pearl Masonic pendant of similar design, unmarked, weight 2.2g, and a Masonic folding ball pendant, opening to reveal engraved Masonic symbols.

### Condition Report

The Masonic ball is unmarked and untested. It is heavily tarnished on the exterior. The hinges and fastenings in generally good condition.

Mother-of-pearl pendant - the applied motif is loose, there appears to have been some damage to the fastening on the reverse of the pendant.

Other two pieces in generally good condition, typical light wear.
