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A platinum, fancy intense yellow diamond and diamond ring, mounted with the asscher cut fancy intense yellow diamond within a two row octagonal surround, mounted with circular cut diamonds between split shoulders, unmarked, weight 4.4g, yellow diamond weight approx 1.10ct, ring size approx N1/2, with an EDR Identification Report and a case.

Estimate: £1,000 - £1,500

Condition Report

Some general scratching and light denting to the edge of the setting, largely visible when viewed under a loupe, to be expected with use.

Some slight wear to the sides of the setting, some thinning to the shank.

One central motif to one shoulder has become detached from the head of the ring, should be easily fixed by a jeweller.

All stones look to be currently secure in their settings.

Art Deco style - but we cannot confirm that the ring dates from this period, possibly 1950s but only an opinion.

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
