### LOT 2030

A William and Mary laburnum oyster veneered collector's cabinet-on-stand, the two doors with walnut feather banding opening to reveal an arrangement of drawers surrounding a central door enclosing further drawers, the frieze fitted with a single drawer and raised on later turned legs united by a stretcher, height 147cm, width 105cm, depth 50cm (some alterations and restoration).

Estimate: £2,000 - £4,000

### Condition Report

2030. The top surface of the cabinet has been later veneered in a sheet of dark stained board. The two doors both have vertical and horizontal cracks to the veneer where the carcass has shrunk. Otherwise just some minor and fairly typical old repairs and surface knocks. The legs and stretchers are later made, probably in the early 20th century.
