### Condition Report

44. 1955 example has very minimal signs of handling, however there is a pin hole to the centre and the reverse has a very light rectangular linear area of browning.

1951 example shows slightly more sign of circulation and handling with areas of minor creasing now flattened out. Some edge browning. Some light brown spots throughout, though more to the back of the note.
