A George III silver baluster cream jug, chased with a beaded cartouche flanked by flowers and leaves, beneath a beaded rim, on a circular foot, London 1785 by Hester Bateman, weight 81.2g, height 13.3cm, and another similar silver cream jug with circular foot and square weighted base, height 16.5cm.

Condition Report

411. Bateman jug - generally good condition, but kink/dent to stem and slightly misshapen foot, wobbles slightly so requires a little attention. Typical light surface scratches and wear. Engraved monogram to front. Slightly rubbed hallmarks - image 2 on our website.

Other jug - generally good condition. Typical surface scratches and wear. Small dents to front cartouche. Weighted base which is probably obscurring the marks to underside. Sits pretty flat. Wear to gilt interior.
